**NOTICE OF DOMESTIC WELL WORKING SESSION**

**THIS MATTER** is before the Special Master pursuant to the Order of Reference [Doc. No. 6336]. All parties are hereby notified that the Special Master will hold a working session with respect to domestic wells on **Tuesday, August 17, 2010 at 2:00 p.m.** in the Jury Assembly Room at the United States Courthouse, South Federal Place, Santa Fe, New Mexico. Matters discussed will include the Status Report filed by Plaintiff the State on May 5, 2010 [Doc. No. 6967] and any issues raised therein, a discussion of the work that remains to be done to complete the identification and adjudication of domestic wells, including but not limited to survey and/or verification work for those wells and the joining of parties, where appropriate, and any other matters relating to the domestic well portion

of the adjudication that attendees wish addressed. **This working session is a dialogue between the Special Master and any attendees. Attendance of attorneys or record and parties is not required, and is discretionary.** Unless a party notifies the Special Master no later than one week prior to the working session that a court reporter is desired, a court reporter will not be in attendance at this working session.

**THE PARTIES ARE NOTIFIED THAT WITHIN 20 DAYS OF SERVICE** of a copy of this order, report, or recommendations, they may file written objections with the Clerk of the Court pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 53(f)(2). **A party must file any objections with the Clerk of the Court within the twenty-day period if that party wants the District Judge to hear their objections. If no objections are filed within the twenty-day period, the District Judge may adopt the order, report or recommendations in whole.**
