For a reference to possible costs, the residents who were connected to the most recent extension last fall reported spending just under \$10,000 to get their houses fully connected. I have heard that the contractor encountered unanticipated problems and that the estimates for future projects might be higher. Before I begin talking to the contractors, I would like to get a better idea of how many households would be interested in moving forward with the extension.

The housing density in the area, especially houses located less than half a mile from Tano Road, is quite high. This could bring down the per-house cost.

I anticipate working out the cost estimates and talking with contractors this winter so that, if possible, we can begin laying piping as soon as the weather warms up in spring.
